



Notice of Privacy Practices and Patient Consent For Use and Disclosure of Protected Health Information

I Understand that under the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPPA), I have certain Patient Rights regarding my protected health information.

I Understand that Van Doorne Hearing Care may use or disclose my protected health information for treatment, payment or health care operations -- which means for providing health care to me, the patient; handling billing and payment; and taking care of other health care operations. Unless required by law, there will no other uses and disclosures of this information without my authorization.
